## WEST BENGAL HOUSING INDUSTRY REGULATION, 2019

## NOTIFICATION

No. 34-HIAT/2019

Dated 5th August, 2019

In the other tribunals VIZ Central Administrative Tribunal, The West Bengal Administrative Tribunal, West Bengal Land Revenue Tenancy Tribunal, West Bengal Taxation Appellate Tribunal etc. though "Dress Code" has been codified but the present Act and Rules of such new set up is silent about the same. It is redundant to mention that the Chairperson and one of the members of such Appellate Tribunal of the West Bengal Housing Industry respectively are selected from amongst the Hon'ble Judges (retired) of High Court at Calcutta and the Judges (retired) of the Districts of West Bengal, and the third one, of course, is selected either from technical side or from administrative side.

Therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon the Chairperson of such Appellate Tribunal under Section 54 of such Act the following regulations are framed to codify the "Dress Code" of the Members and officers of the Appellate Tribunal, and the practitioners attending the Tribunal.

- The Chairperson and the Judicial Member of such Appellate Tribunal while sitting to conduct the Tribunal, shall be with full robe of a judge or a Judicial officer, as the case may be.
- 2) Whereas the "Dress Code" of the Technical/the Administrative Member of such Tribunal while sitting in the Tribunal, shall be in a presentable manner, who shall wear Full sleeve white shirt with black coat and black Tie.
- A legal practitioner or as the case may be, a presenting officer, shall appear before the Tribunal in his professional dress, if any, and if there is no such dress.

- i) if a male, in a closed collared coat or in an open collared coat with white shirt, trousers and a tie;
- ii) if a female, in a saree or in any other customary dress of any light colour.
